## Spelling Homework Ideas

You and your child may choose one assignment from the list below. Please choose something that will best help your child learn how to spell the words. Try several of the ideas and see what works best for your child.

1. Have an adult give you a written spelling pre-test. The adult needs to correct the test and you write the misspelled words correctly three times each.

2. Write the spelling words in alphabetical order.

3. Write each spelling word two times.

4. Spell each word aloud to an adult. Repeat missed words until you know them.

5. Write a story using the spelling words. Underline the spelling words you use.

6. Scramble the letters of each word and then write them correctly.

7. Get a newspaper and open it up. Use the newspaper instead of regular paper to write on. Using a red crayon or marker, write each spelling word, HUGE, on the newspaper. (Red writing on a black and white background can help the words stay in our memory longer.)

8. Rainbow write the words in cursive. Write each word three times on top of itself using three different colors. Make sure one is red. (Red helps with memory.)

9. Write each word and draw a picture for at least half of the words.

10. Write the words on a chalk or whiteboard. Pretend you are the teacher.

11. Type the spelling words on the computer two times each.

12. Spell each word aloud as you jump using a jump rope, trampoline, or rebounder.

13. Go to **Spellingcity.com** and do one or more of the activities.

14. Use watercolors to paint your spelling words.

15. Spell out the spelling words with alphabet macaroni. You can choose to glue the letters to paper to turn in.
