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Subject-Verb Agreement

The subject of a sentence is a noun that tells whom or what the sentence is about. The verb is an action word that tells what the subject is or does. The subject and the verb in a sentence must match in number (singular or plural).

Singular: Valerie **loves** her brothers very much.

Plural: Ben and Marco **love** their sister, too.
