Subject-Verb Agreement

The subject of a sentence tells whom or what the sentence is about. The verb is an action word that tells what the subject is or does. The subject and the verb in a sentence must agree in number and person. Most singular verbs end in **-s**. Removing the final **-s** makes the verbs plural.

That **girl plays** soccer.
